Hearsay Exceptions CPSRT

Statements Made for Purposes of Medical Diagnosis or Treatment

Such evidence can be helpful since the child's statement to a Doctor is more than just an out of court statement of a child requiring corroboration for a finding

The takeaway for CPS is ALWAYS attempt to use the actual words uttered as well as observing and documenting the demeanor of the speaker.
